GUIDE TO OCEAN CITY CAMPGROUND & BEACH CABINS

PLEASE REVIEW AND FOLLOW TO ENSURE THE SAFETY AND ENJOYMENT FOR ALL OUR GUESTS!

• **Speed Limit:** 9MPH Please use caution children at play!

• **Check in:** 3:00pm. Early check-ins welcome at no additional cost if you site is available.

• **Check out:** 1:00pm. Any guest on site after 1pm will be charged an additional night. Check out for cabins is at noon.

• **Guests:** A maximum of 8 guests permitted per RV site and are included in the nightly rate.

• Quiet Hours: 11:00pm – 8:00am. Generators, diesel engines or bright exterior lighting may not operate during the quiet hours. No loud music, excessive noise, or disorderly conduct will be tolerated.

• Alcohol: Restricted to the campsite. Please drink responsibly. Violators will be asked to leave.

• Smoking: Restricted to the campsite.

• **Pets:** Pets are welcome for all guests traveling in an RV. Maximum of 2 pets per site. Pets are welcome in cabins \$15 per night.

• Vehicles: Each campsite is permitted to have ONE vehicle per site. If a second vehicle is required, it must be registered in the office. A charge of \$10 per day will be applied to all short-term guests.

• Firewood: The New Jersey Department of Agriculture has issued a notice prohibiting the movement of all species of firewood into the State. DO NOT bring any firewood to the campground. Firewood is available on site at all times through our firewood kiosk! The kiosk offers a bundle of wood and accepts cash and credit cards.

• Fires: You are responsible for your fire. Do not leave it unattended. All fires must be kept inside the provided fire ring and the flames should not exceed 1 foot over the ring. No outside rings permitted on site. Enjoy the S'MORES!

• **Golf Carts:** Permitted but must be registered in the office. Operator must have valid Drivers License and insurance. No ATVs.

• **Children:** 12 and under must be accompanied by an adult 18 any time they are off the campsite in the park.

• **Visitors:** Day guest visitors are welcome to visit from 8am – 10pm for a fee of \$6.00 person or \$10 per vehicle. Please register at the front office upon arrival

• **Drones:** For the privacy of our guests drones are not permitted on property unless otherwise approved by management.

• Garbage: Household trash only violators will be fined or removed. Please refer to the map for locations of dumpsters—recycle?

• **Fireworks and Weapons:** Fireworks (including sparklers), firecrackers, explosives, firearms or weapons of any kind are not permitted

• Our swimming pool is heated so guests can enjoy swimming earlier and longer into the season!

• No one knows for sure who invented the s'more. However, the first published recipe for "some mores" was in a 1927 publication of Tramping and Trailing with the Girl Scouts. Loretta Scott Crew, who made them for Girl Scouts by the campfire, is given credit for the recipe. And in case you forgot to bring your own, we have plenty available in the store!

• Ocean City, New Jersey was originally named Peck's Beach. The island that is now Ocean City began in the 1700s when founder John Peck utilized the area for fresh whale storage. The island later served many functions until the mid-1800s when the island gained its first full-time resident.

• Ocean City's beach measures about 8 miles long, with the boardwalk being 2.5 miles long.

• Ocean City is a dry town. Different than the other Jersey shore beach towns, there are no liquor stores, bars or BYOB restaurants in town. This is a continued tradition from the town's early years, where Ocean City was a Christian resort.
